She has a private practice of psychiatry and psychoanalysis with children, adolescents and adults in Washington, D.C. and is a supervising child and adolescent analyst at the Cleveland and Seattle Psychoanalytic Institutes, Clinical Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences and Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at the George Washington University School of Medicine. She is also a member of the board of trustees, Sigmund Freud Archives, a member of the Center for Advanced Psychoanalytic Studies in Princeton, New Jersey and Aspen, Colorado, on the editorial board of the *Psychoanalytic Quarterly* and *The Journal of the American Psychoanalytic Association*, and a reader for *The International Journal of Psychoanalysis*.
